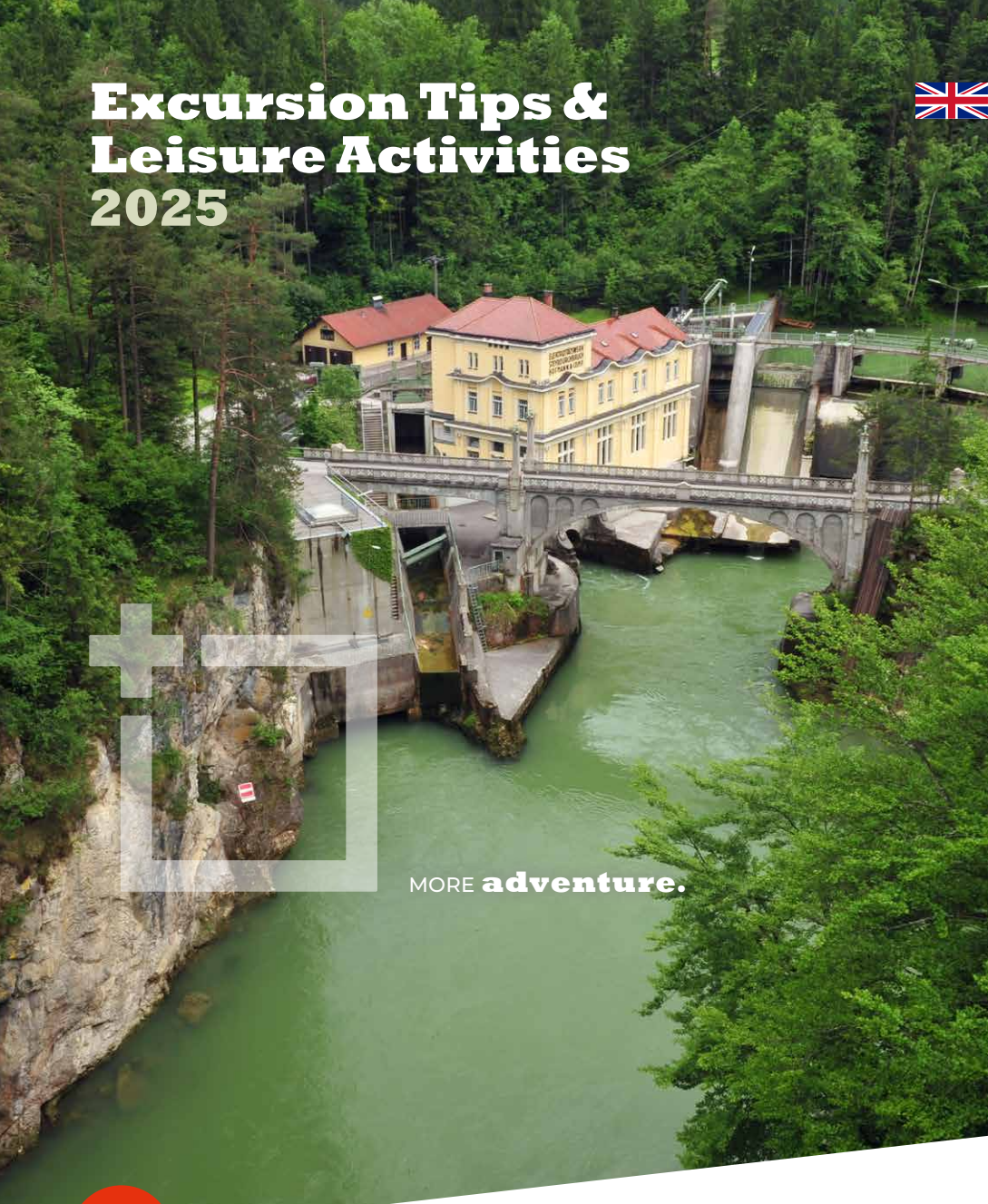

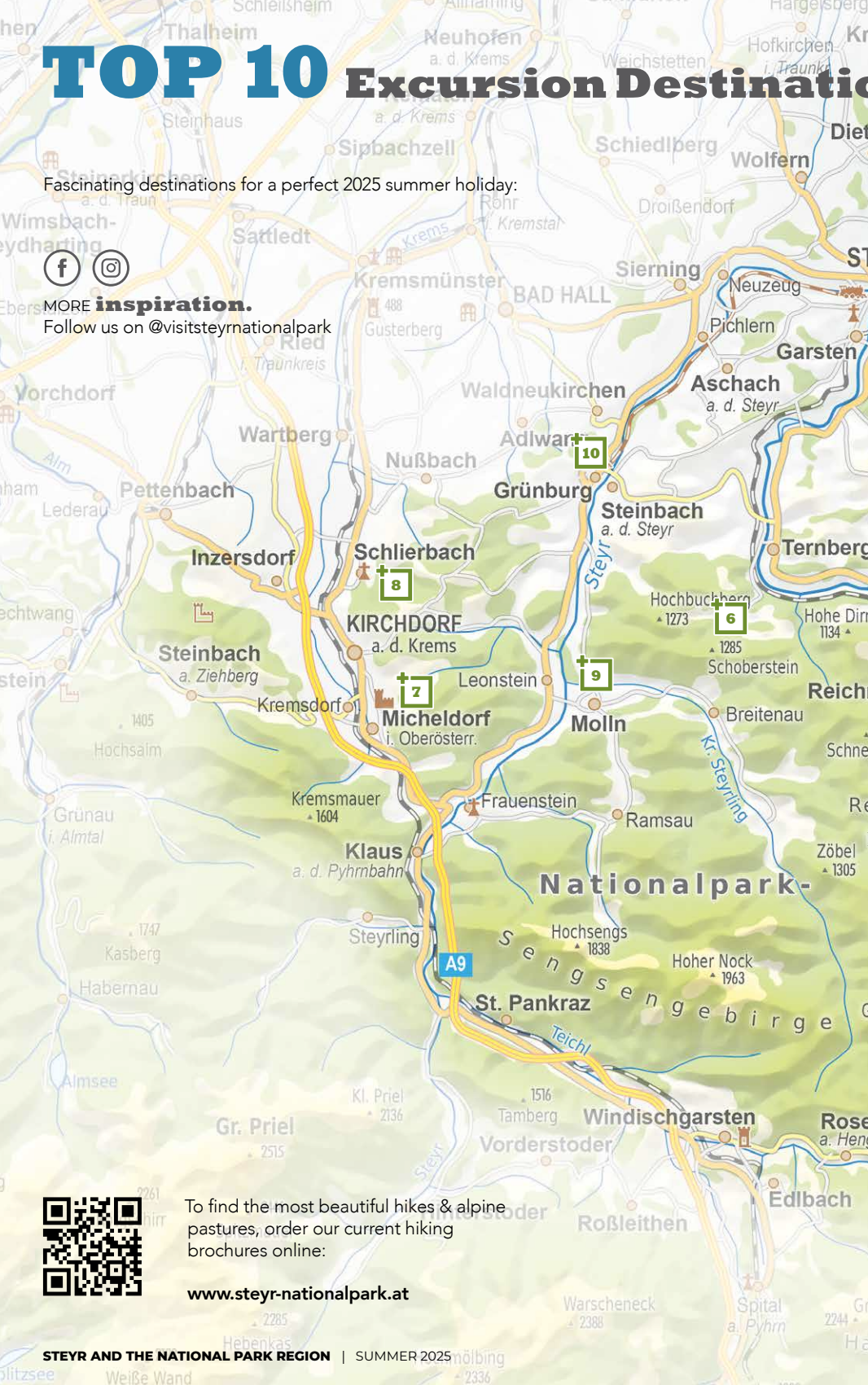

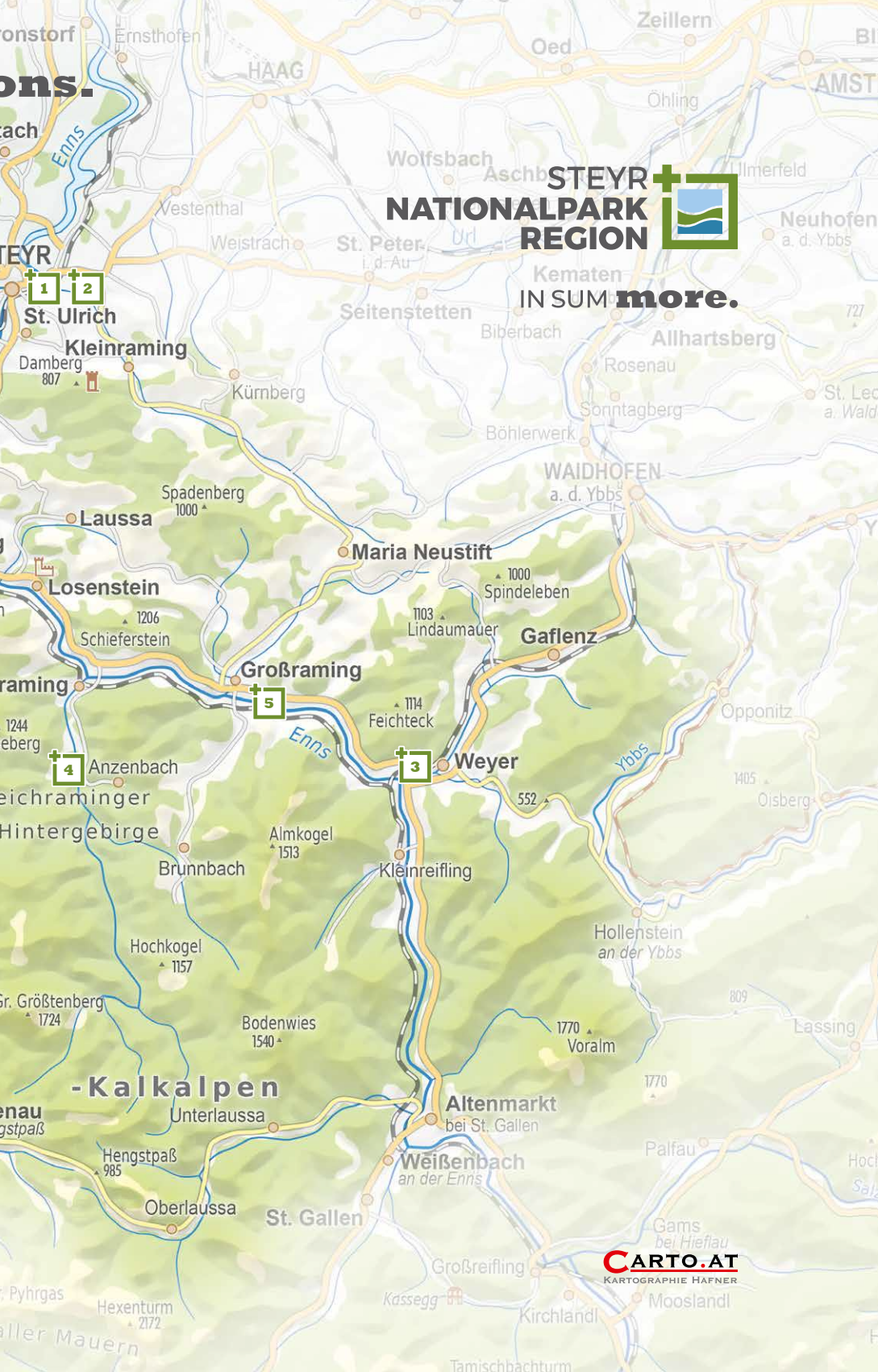

1 Steyr Old Town

A unique spectacle of nature awaits you in the centre of Steyr's old town where the green Enns and crystal clear Steyr rivers magnificently flow together. In the Stadtplatz Square town houses dating back to various stylistic epochs stand harmoniously side by side. The old "Wehrgraben" today is a popular residential area as well as home to a college and the Arbeitswelt Museum. > P. 4

3 Katzensteiner Mill with Granary and Gang Saw

The fully functional mill from the year 1820 was dismantled at its original location and rebuilt on the Gafrenz stream in Weyer by the Katzensteiner family in 1978. The mill is used to give demonstrations on the production of flour and semolina. The history of milling is displayed in the granary. > P. 12

5 Rafting on the Enns River

Farming Technology Museum

**Steyrdurchbruch
 Jugendstil Power Plant**

The impressive hydroelectric power plant was built by Mauriz Balzarek. A special highlight is the arch bridge downstream of the dam wall. The original Francis turbines dating back to 1908 are still in operation. The true treasure however is the Steyr River itself: the longest river starting and ending in Upper Austria with drinking water quality from source to mouth.
